Modular Plant Rooms

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Four Modular AHU plant rooms were provided as part of a prestigious five storey Office development. Weighing over 30 Tonne each, the modules were fully assembled on site at ground level and lifted onto the 23m high roof. A 500T mobile crane was used to land them onto fully water tight stubs.









Key Points:-

Steel frame built on temporary supports adjacent the main building.

- Cladding and plant items were fully fixed at ground level. This included the air handling units, piped services, valve sets, chilled water pumps, heat exchangers wiring and controls.
- 2. Welded lifting lugs hidden in the parapet can be used for demolition.
- 3. Major Cost savings through constructing at ground level.
- 4. Small link areas to staircases were completed at roof level.
- 5. Expensive full height scaffold to outside edges was eliminated.
- 6. Overall programme was reduced as modules could be constructed as the main building progressed. Estimated at 8 weeks total time saving.
- 7. Improved quality control and site safety produced zero accidents.

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
