
Quicker Steel Drilling

Most fabrication companies of any size have an automated cut and drill line. This offers multi-head automated drilling of steelwork using CNC files downloaded from computer generated models from Strucad or Xsteel.



Key Points:-

- 1. Keeping holes in line means that all faces can be drilled at the same time.
- 2. Members could be drilled up to 3 times faster.
- 3. Fabricators recover all or most of their overheads on the shop hours. Saving time in fabrication is a top priority if you want to be competitive.
- It's surprising how many detailers do not realize that if the holes are in line in 4. opposite flanges and the web, this means quicker drilling.
- 5. Some plates may end up none symmetrical but you have to weigh up symmetry verses shop time. Shop time will usually come out on top.
