

Water Tanks (storage cisterns) & Legionella Risk Assessments



To carry out legionella risk assessments on commercial water systems that use water tanks to give a) a head of water, & b) a reserve supply of water.

Tanks require many regular checks that can be time consuming and expensive.



- For areas where the water supplier provides water at a good pressure and there is no requirement for storage then the tank can be removed and all water equipment can be supplied straight off the mains.
- The tank needs to be disconnected, drained and removed off site so it can't be reused.
- All old pipework to be either stripped out or isolated.
- Any existing legionella risk assessments and maintenance programmes should be amended to suit.
