Hard Standing for Construction Phase

The Problem / Challenge

Inclement weather on building sites causes all sorts of issues including muddy access roads, wet storage areas and poor access for construction .

The Risks

Access to the site or areas of construction restricted, damage to materials & not been able to work safely due to wet & muddy under foot conditions.

The Solution

Good pre-construction plan that allows the hard-landscaped areas to be laid immediately after the foundations are complete (please note that the final wearing course should not be completed at this stage)

The Benefits

Safe access on site is immeasurable in todays construction site. It will have benefits to site safety, programme and buildability.

Key Points

Completed underground drainage plan with good planning at preconstruction phase as it may not be suitable to every site however it may be of benefit that temporary hard-landscaped areas that are not part of the final scheme are used for the construction stage only.
