



## Locking off Isolators

Here a plastic cable tie has been used to “lock” off an isolator.

This case study explains why this is “*Not the recommended method*”, and what the correct procedure should be.



### The “Not Recommended Method”

- A plastic tie can be easily cut and removed by anyone.
- No Label is present to inform:
  - (a) Who has locked it off?
  - (b) Why it is locked off.
  - (c) Date it was locked off.
  - (d) Contact number of person responsible for isolation.

### The “Recommended Method”

- Use a padlock with an adequate label.
